ProMedica Fostoria Community Hospital Foundation administers four scholarship funds which promote healthcare professions among Fostoria area students. Founded by local physicians, nurses and their families, the eligibility requirements for each Fund's scholarship are specific to the establishing donor's request. Over the years, these funds have assisted hundreds of local students. Scholarship awards range from \$500 to \$1,500. Scholarships are awarded annually. Past recipients may reapply in subsequent years.

Foundation Scholarship Funds:

G.H.W. Bruggemann Memorial Scholarship Fund

Basic Requirements

- Employee or dependent of a ProMedica Fostoria Community Hospital employee with at least three years of service
- Enrolled full-time in healthcare-related field in an accredited degree program

J.L. Murphy Memorial Fund

Basic Requirements

- Graduate of Fostoria area high school (Arcadia, Bettsville, Elmwood, Fostoria, Hopewell-Loudon, Lakota, New Riegel, or St. Wendelin)
- Enrolled or accepted into a school of medicine

J.A. Murray Memorial Scholarship Fund

Basic Requirements

- Resident of the ProMedica Fostoria Community Hospital service area (Fostoria and adjacent zip codes)
- Enrolled or accepted into a medical degree program (physician) or other traditional healthcare degree program, such as nursing, pharmacy, radiology, respiratory, physical therapy, occupational therapy and speech therapy)

Ruth Nichols Sollars Nursing Education Scholarship Fund

Basic Requirements

- Nurse currently enrolled in a nursing program at an accredited college or university pursuing a higher-level of education as a nurse (LPN to RN, RN to BSN, etc.)
- Employees of ProMedica Fostoria Community Hospital are encouraged to apply
