Who are "Registered and Active Parishioners" at Saint Wendelin Parish?

Registered and active parishioners of Saint Wendelin Parish will qualify for parishioner tuition assistance/scholarship for your children who will attend a Catholic school of your choice by being currently registered and demonstrating active commitment to the parish. Registered and Active Parishioners:

1. Participate in the liturgical and sacramental life of the parish;
2. Attend and participate at Mass on Sundays, Holy Days of Obligation and Holidays;
3. Are formed and educated for the Sacraments of Baptism, First Reconciliation, First Eucharist, and Confirmation at Saint Wendelin Parish (by Toledo Diocesan Pastoral policy);
4. Are committed annually to the parish through gifts of time, talent and treasure; (While no service hours are tracked for time and talent, weekly offertory envelopes for all parishioners are recorded (for tax purposes). These weekly offertory envelope records will, in part, serve to determine "active" commitment. Important to note: offering or tithing amounts will not be evaluated. Envelopes indicate attendance and participation. Absence allowed: 6 weekends away for vacation, 4 weekends sick. Any absences after these will be evaluated to determine future scholarships.
5. Actively work to participate in the mission of the parish and the Church with special concern for volunteerism to the parish through gifts of time and talent.
